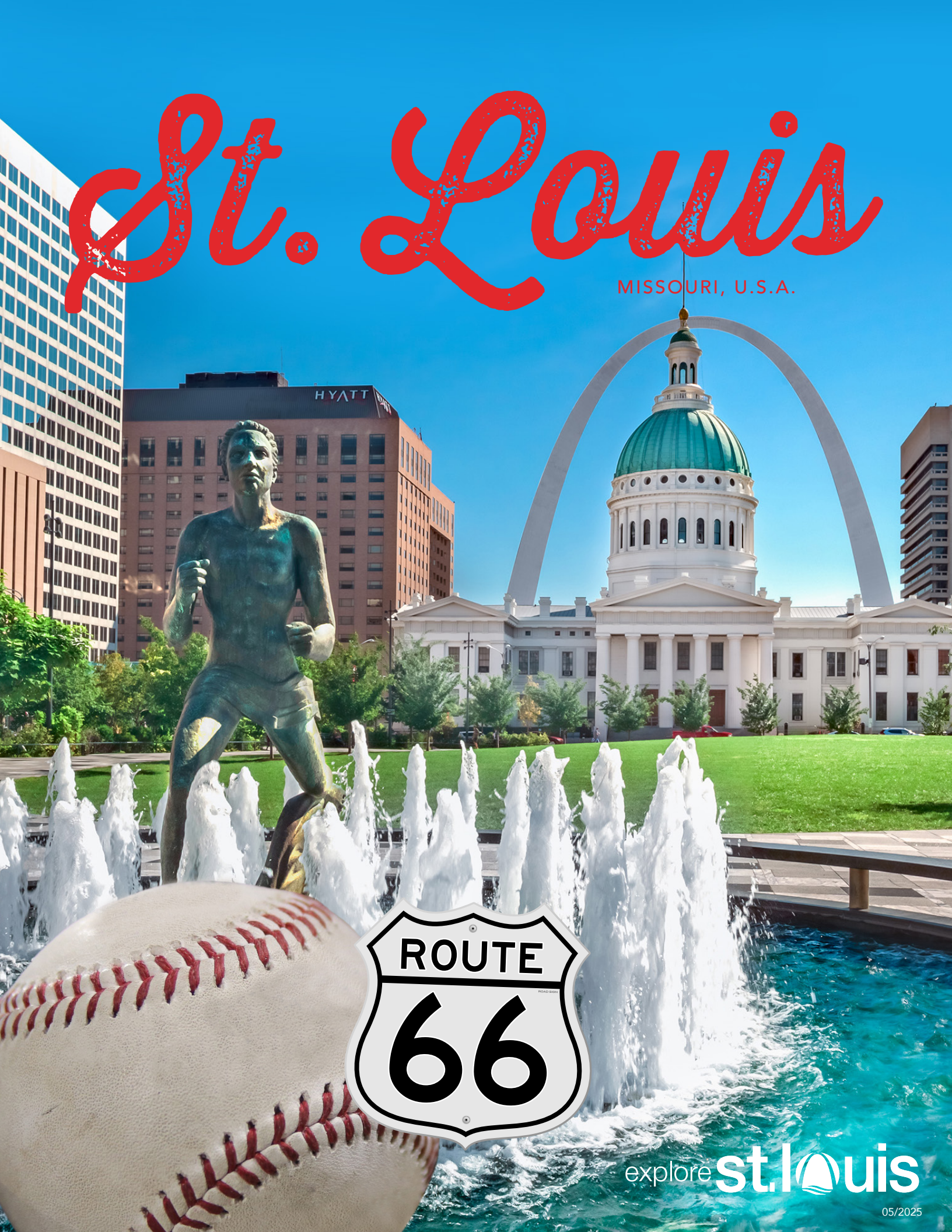

Get your kicks in the city that put Route 66 on the map.

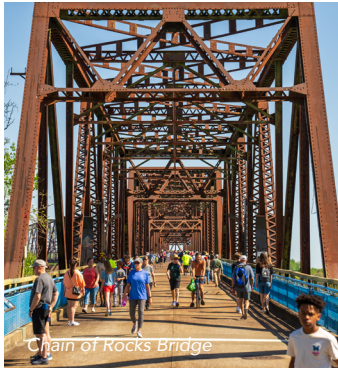

- Easy access from major Midwest cities within a four hour drive, like Chicago, Kansas City, Indianapolis, Nashville and Memphis



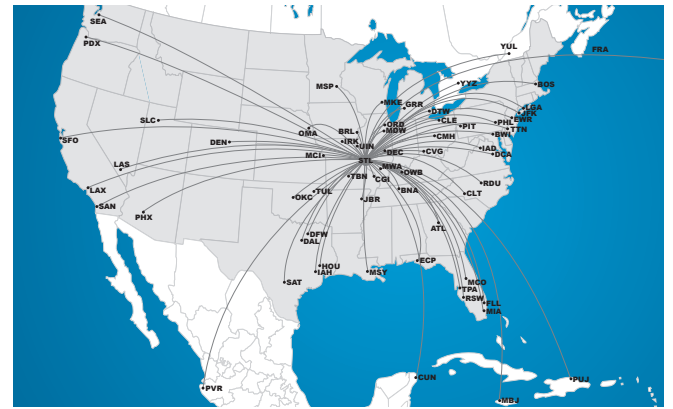

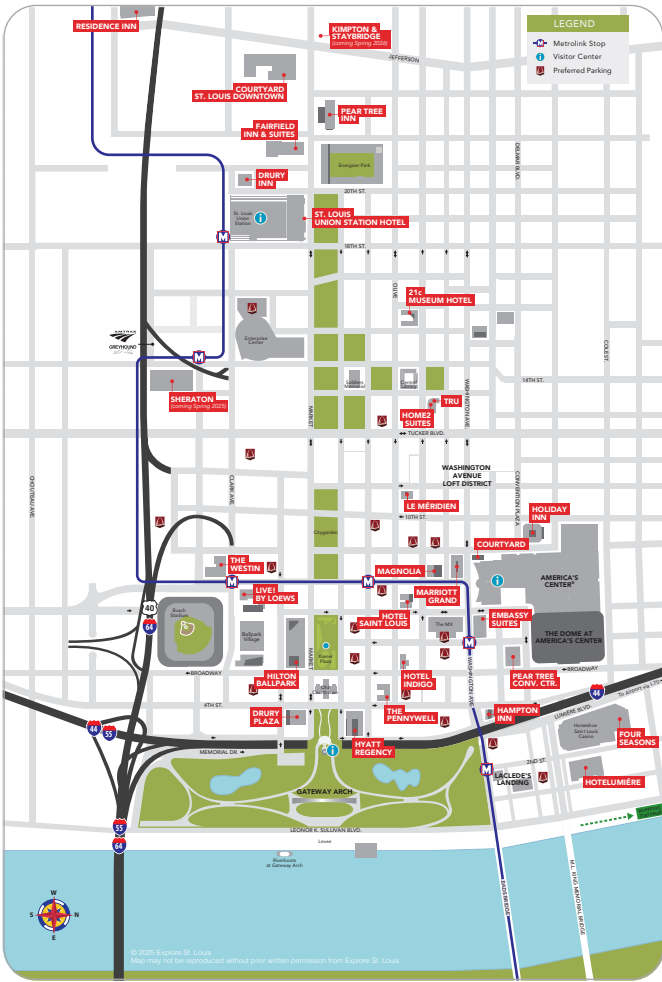
